A pledge made to support HIV & AIDS by a staff member and patients



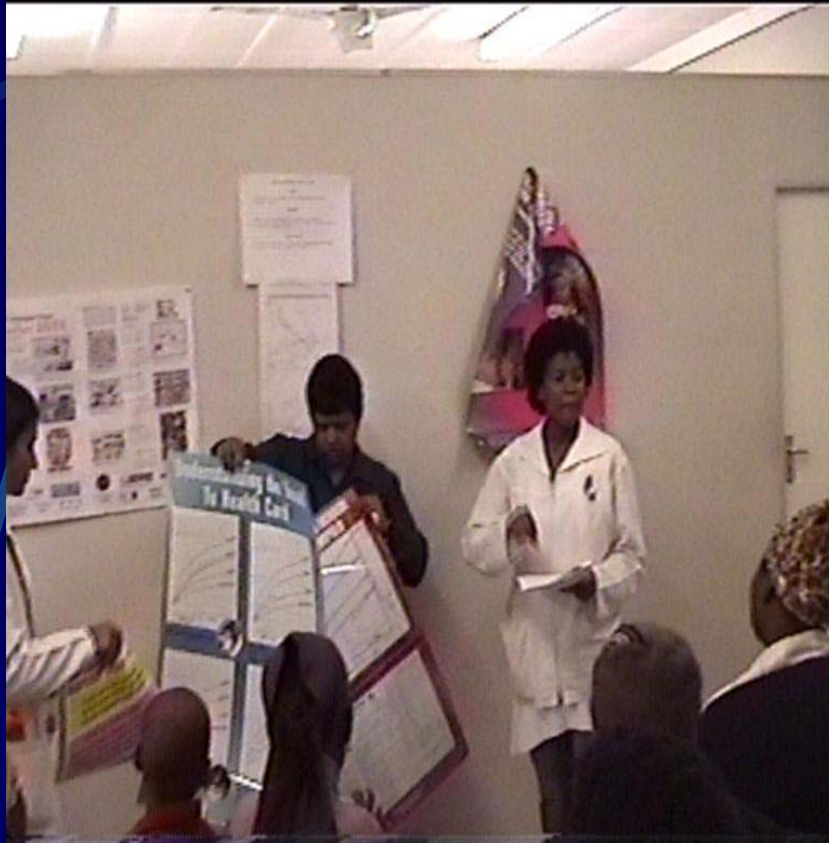
CLINIC VISITS

Pupils were treated to fruit and yoghurt, after a talk on Healthy Lifestyle, Dental Care and the do's and don'ts of taking medication

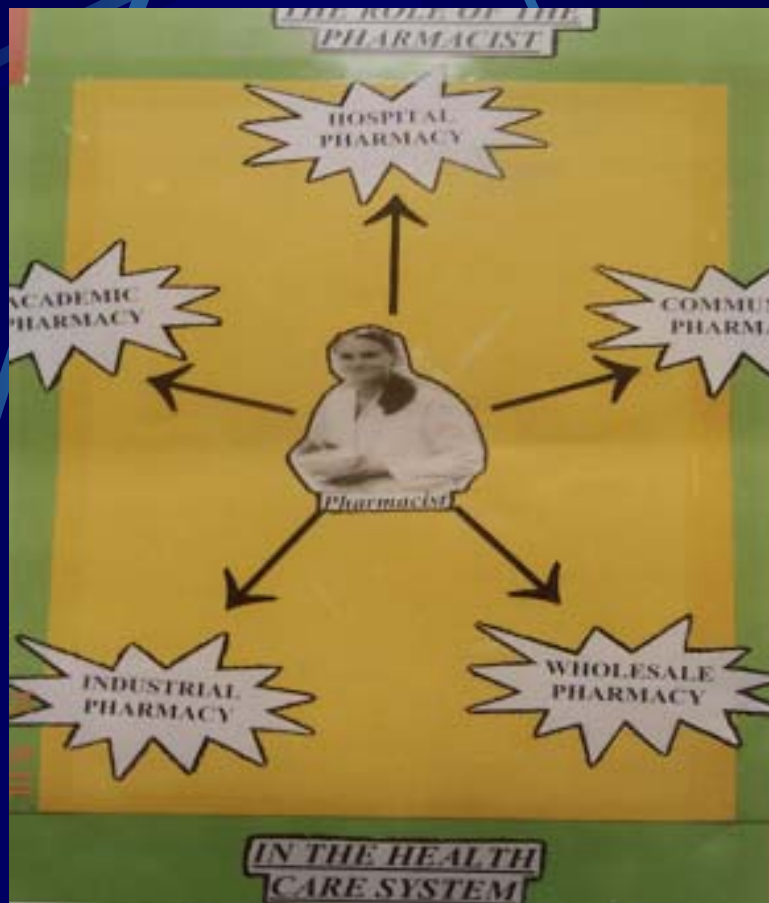
