

JOBS NOT FOR SALE

The KwaZulu-Natal Department of Health has again become the target of job scammers, this time purporting to offer employment at various Hospitals, especially, **Dr Pixley Ka Isaka Seme Memorial Hospital**.

The fake advert claims to seek candidates for jobs for various positions within Hospitals for permanent and contractual employments.

The Department urges members of the public to avoid falling victims to such scams, and rather familiarise themselves with the recruitment processes of the Department, and to note that:

- The Department advertises its vacancies on reputable newspapers, the Department of Public Service and Administration's website (dpsa.gov.za), and its own official website (kznhealth.gov.za).
- There is never any amount of money requested, on the printed advert or telephonically. This act would constitute bribery, which is illegal and a criminal offence.
- There is always a reference number included for every advert.
- The Department currently only receives physical applications for employment, not via email or fax.

The Department encourages the public to exercise caution, and verify all adverts circulated on social media with the above mentioned sites, or telephone the Department on **033 395 2111** (HR Section), and confirm the authenticity of positions.
