A head injury is any trauma to the scalp, skull or brain. Head injury can be closed or open. Closed injury means, you received a hard blow to the head from striking an object, but the object did not break the skull.

SYSMPTOMS OF A HEAD INJURY ARE:

- Confusion
- Headache
- Dislike of noise or light
- Nausea
- Balance problems
- Blurred vision
- Difficulty concentrating
- Fatigue

HOW TO PREVENT HEAD INJURY

Always wear a seat belt in a car, use a car safety seats, never drink and drive, wear a helmet in s bicycle or motorbike, use hand rails on stairs, adequate lighting on stairs, check for obstacles in pathway and correct safety equipment for workers.
