POLIO AND MEASLES CAMPAIGN







The Polio and Measles campaign is recognized all over South Africa. The first phase of the campaign was from the 05 – 13 May and the second round on the 21—29 July 2007.

POLIO is an illness that causes sudden weakness of the limbs and sometimes death in children and it affects mostly children under the age of five. MEASLES can occur in infants and even adults. Measles is a highly infectious diseases that causes high fever, fine red rash, flu-like symptoms. Measles vaccine is given as an injection in the thigh or upper arm. Polio can be prevented by immunization with polio drops at birth, 6 weeks, 10 weeks, 14 weeks, 18 months and 5 years of age

In order to ensure that people brought their children to the announced points for injections and drops a need was recognised to organize an awareness event first. This event was aimed at telling people about the dangers of Polio and Measles. These diseases are highly dangerous and could end up causing disabilities and death in children.

There are difficulties when doing this campaign, it needs a lot of dedication and hard work. As you can see the above pictures of some of the places that our PHC team visited. Montebello is a rural area and some of the places were hard to reach and were only reached with the assistance of an aero plane.

Production of accurate and reliable data is very important for our hospital. The facility information officer is in place to meet the standards lay down by the department of health. He collects and collate data, daily in accordance with the National Health requirements. His ongoing support to quality improvement programmes is essential. All graphical statistics should be displayed on the notice boards. This involves managing a functional information system that involves planning, monitoring and evaluation at all The FIO also assists with the conduction of hospital surveys.

The maintenance of constant supply of reliable and accurate information to facilitate planning at levels and this information is used in hospital planning.

The data is also analysed and interpreted all data received in meaningful and comprehensive report.
