

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS NGO FUNDING 2020/21 – 2022/2023

The KwaZulu-Natal Department of Health invites not-for-profit organisations which provide health services within the province to apply for funding for a 3-year funding cycle beginning in April 2020 & ending in March 2023. Funding is to support, supplement, extend, expand or strengthen service delivery reach of the Department in the following priority areas:

- i) Palliative / hospice & step down care services
- (ii) Mental health care services (residential / halfway house / day care / community outreach / training)
- iii) Disability & rehabilitation services, and
- iv) Primary health care services

Eligibility

Applicants must illustrate prior experience and willingness to generate maximum impact with the lowest possible use of resources & must:

- be a not-for-profit organisation providing services within the boundaries of the Province of KwaZulu-Natal
- fully & comprehensively complete the application form, and attach proof of the latest valid registration certificate
- submit audited financial statements, and other documents stated on the application form
- submit a 3-year business plan which illustrates, inter alia, how their activities will support the Department in extending, supplement, expanding or strengthening one or more of the priority areas listed above, and
- ensure that the application reaches the Department on or before the closing date

How to Apply

The following are required from applicants who wish to be considered for funding:

- visit or contact the nearest Health District Office (or Head Office if your service has / would have a province-wide footprint) to obtain the application form & its templates
- complete the application form and deliver / post it back before the closing date. E-mail / fax shall not be accepted

Details of the Department Offices

Applications shall be evaluated, at first, by the respective Health District Office (or relevant Head Office Unit for applications with province-wide footprint) to assess the desirability & the need for the services applied for before being presented by the District / Unit concerned to the provincial Head Office Committee for consideration.
