- The institution is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote.
- The price quoted must include VAT (if VAT vendor). However, it must be noted that the department reserves the right to evaluate all 3.2. quotations excluding VAT as some bidders may not be VAT vendors.

STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the 6.1. Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

7. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

Should a bidder wish to qualify for preference points they must complete a SBD 6.1 document. Failure by a bidder to provide all 7.1. relevant information required, will result in such a bidder not being considered for preference point's allocation. The preferences applicable on the closing date will be utilized. Any changes after the closing date will not be considered for that particular quote.

8. TAX COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS
