SPECIAL CONTRACT CONDITIONS OF QUOTATIONS

1. AMENDMENT OF CONTRACT

1.1. Any amendment to or renunciation of the provisions of the contract shall at all times be done in writing and shall be signed by both parties.

2. CHANGE OF ADDRESS

2.1. Bidders must advise the Department of Health (institution where the offer was submitted) should their address (domicilium citandi et executandi) details change from the time of bidding to the expiry of the contract.

3. GENERAL CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS QUOTATION

- 3.1. The institution is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote.
- 3.2. The price quoted must include VAT (if VAT vendor). However, it must be noted that the department reserves the right to evaluate all quotations excluding VAT as some bidders may not be VAT vendors.
- 3.3. The bidder must ensure the correctness & validity of quote:
 - (i) that the price(s), rate(s) & preference quoted cover all for the work/item (s) & accept that any mistakes regarding the price (s) & calculations will be at the bidder's risk
- 3.4. The bidder must accept full responsibility for the proper execution & fulfilment of all obligations conditions devolving on under this agreement, as the Principal (s) liable for the due fulfilment of this contract.
- 3.5. This quotation will be evaluated based on the 80/20 points system, specification & correctness of information. All required documentation must be completed in full and submitted.
- 3.6. Offers must comply strictly with the specification.

STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

7. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

Should a bidder wish to qualify for preference points they must complete a SBD 6.1 document. Failure by a bidder to provide all 7.1. relevant information required, will result in such a bidder not being considered for preference point's allocation. The preferences applicable on the closing date will be utilized. Any changes after the closing date will not be considered for that particular quote.

This quotation calls for the complete inspection, servicing, preventative maintenance and repair of fire extinguisher. The service is required for the month of 2019 June

REQUIREMENTS

- The Contractor will be requested to visit the site to take all measurement necessary.
- Contractors are also advised to be present on site meeting for anything that might be discussed outside the specification
- The competed workmen skilled in their trades shall carry out all work.
- Quality shall be of the best standard practice and workmanship shall be subject to the approval of the Hospital Representative.
- During the progress of work the Contractor shall carefully clean up after his /her men and shall leave the area and the portion of the building clean and free from debris.
- Only contractors on the valid permit to apply the SABS standardization mark Diamond mark will be considered. The technician serving the equipment must register with the S.A.Q.C.C. (South African Qualification for Fire Industry) NOTE; a copy of these certificates must be furnished with this quotation.
- If it is considered necessary to remove any Fire Fighting Equipment to the
 contractors' works for servicing, the contractor shall state the time required
 in writing to carry out such a service. Under such circumstances, the
 equipment must replaced by similar unit on loan to the institution at no
 cost to the institution, until such time the removed equipment has been
 serviced, returned and reinstalled.
- The Contractor will be required to conform to the Security and other Regulations imposed by the Health Service Department and in addition are to provide suitable means of identification of all workmen employed on his/her work to the approval of the Hospital.
- The Contractor is also advised to comply with Health and Safety Regulations while performing duties on the Hospital premises.
