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**SPECIFICATION
FOR
THE SNAKE REPELLENT AT
BENEDICTINE CLINIC**

This quotation calls for a competent Month to month service of Snake control / repellent at the Clinic for a period of three Months.

REQUIREMENTS

- The Contractor will be requested to visit the Clinic to view the arrears and structures.
- Contractors are also advised to be present on site meeting in case of anything that might be discussed outside the specification
- The competed workmen skilled in their trades shall carry out all work.
- During the progress of work the Contractor shall carefully clean up after his /her men and shall leave the area and the portion of the building clean and free from debris.
- The contractor must provide proof or license for conducting pest control services
- The chemicals used shall be SABS approved and authorized to be used for hospital environment.
- The Contractor will be required to conform to the Security and other Regulations imposed by the Health Service Department and in addition are to provide suitable means of identification of all workmen employed on his/her work to the approval of the Hospital.
- The Contractor is also advised to comply with Health and Safety Regulations while performing duties on the Hospital premises.
- No variation will be entertained for non-complying with paragraph one of this document.

PROGRAMME & JOB TO BE DONE

The contractor is request to provide a month to month service of Snake repellent; dealing with/ eliminating: 1. all types of Snakes

- After every month service the contractor shall produce a report/ certification as confirmation or proof of the service provided.
- The Certificate or report shall be an official standard and be signed by the contractor/ even stamped with all the details of the contractor such as: Name, address, telephone and registration numbers.
- The Report/ certificate shall also specify the names of chemicals used during the service.
- The contractor shall also guarantee each month service, and shall be available to re- conduct the service if any identified pests have been reported before the service is due.
- The contractor shall sign the log book provided at the hospital whenever they are on site.
- Time is considered to this contract and Contractors taking quotations are advised if necessary to discuss the program for the work with the Hospital Representative on Technical Division before submitting quotations
- The Contractor shall carry out his/her work in such a manner as to suit the Hospital Management.
- Contract period for this work shall be a one year contact.
