1) The tenderer to collect, pack, dispatch hospital supplies and asset from various storage locations to end users within the hospital and satellite clinics, daily or on adhoc basis.	
2) The job require counting therefore, the tenderer must employ one (1) Team Leader (supervisor), five (5) workers of which four (4) must be males and two (2) females who are Youth within catchment area. The youth must have at least matric and least three months exposure to stock management or supply chain management preferable from hospital environment.
