1. AMENDMENT OF CONTRACT

Any amendment to or renunciation of the conversions of the contract shall at all times be done in writing and shall be signed by both carties.

2. CHANGE OF ADDRESS

Bidders must advise the Department of Health (institution where the offer was submitted) should their address (domicitum citandi et executandi) details change from the time of bidding to the expiry of the contract,

3. GENERAL CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS QUOTATION

- The institution is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote.

8. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

8.1. The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed, if he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.
