2.1. Bidders must advise the Department of Health (institution where the offer was submitted) should their address (domicilium citandi et executandi) details change from the time of bidding to the expiry of the contract.

3. GENERAL CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS QUOTATION

- 3.1. The institution is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote.
- 3.2. The price quoted must include VAT (if VAT vendor). However, it must be noted that the department reserves the right to evaluate all quotations excluding VAT as some bidders may not be VAT vendors.
- 3.3. The bidder must ensure the correctness & validity of quote:

8. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

8.1. The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

9. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

9.1. Should a bidder wish to qualify for preference points they must complete a SBD 6.1 document. Failure by a bidder to provide all relevant information required, will result in such a bidder not being considered for preference point's allocation. The preferences applicable on the closing date will be utilized. Any changes after the closing date will not be considered for that particular quote.

SPESIFICATION

RELOCATING HOT WATER STORAGE VESSEL FROM I BLOCK TO MORTUARY

1. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Bidders are to make special note of the following:

The whole installation shall be in accordance with the Occupational Health and Safety Act 85/1993 and all regulations framed therein shall be carried out to the satisfaction of the Department of Health.

Competent workmen skilled in their trade shall carry out all work. Quality shall be of the best standard practice and all workmanship will be subject to the approval of the Department of Health.

The work shall at all times, for the duration of the contract, be carried out under the supervision of a skilled and competent representative of the Contractor, who will be able and authorized to receive and carry out instructions on behalf of the Contractor. A sufficient number of workmen shall be employed at all times to ensure satisfactory progress of the work.

All apparatus, component parts, fittings and materials employed in the execution of the Contract shall be new and unused and shall be the latest type or pattern of the particular manufacture employed. S.A.B.S. mark bearing items shall be used wherever possible.

The works executed by the contractor, must be guaranteed against defective parts and workmanship for a period of twelve months after the date of issue of the Completion Certificate.

Rates are to include for commissioning and testing of the complete installation and handing over in working order ready for use.

Bidders are advised to visit the site and acquaint themselves fully with the site conditions and nature and full extent of work involved prior to submitting their tender. Claims on the grounds of insufficient information in such respects or otherwise will not be entertained by the Administration.

The Administration reserves the right to make emergency repairs to keep the equipment in operation without voiding the Contractor's Guarantee, nor relieving the Contractor of his responsibility during the guarantee period when, after proper notice, the Contractor fails to attend to such emergency repairs. All costs incurred by the Administration under these circumstances will be for the account of the Contractor.

NOTE: All electrical equipment shall comply with NER Regulation of voltage

2. REGULATIONS & CIDB GRADING

- a) The works, staff, material and components of the hot water storage system, shall comply where applicable ,with the latest requirements of:
 - i) The Occupational Health and Safety Act (Act 85, 1993) as amended.
 - ii) ISO 3834-1Structural steel works and welding procedures.
 - iii) SANS 10142_2 Electrical installations.
 - iv) SANS 347-2012_2 Pressure vessel regulation

2.1 CIDB GRADING

- Mechanical work require CIDB ME level 3 grading
- ii) Electrical work require EB level 3 grading

2.2 SKILED STAFF REQUIRED FOR WORKS

- a) SAWI coded welder Structural welding Attach certified CV to tender document.

- c) Artisan with rigging qualification or rigging in part of his qualification Attach certified CV to tender Document.

3. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

Mechanical Section

- a) Remove all existing lagging and cladding carefully (Cladding to be reinstalled once unit is in Mortuary hot water plant)
- b) Rig out hot water storage vessel from I Block hot water plant and place it in front of the boiler house.
- c) Inspect tank inside and outside for any corrosion and structure defects.
- d) Cut tank in halve and v prepare all edges for re-welding assembly in Mortuary plant.
- e) Allow for Structural and socket repairs of tank and AIA testing should it be needed.
- f) 3 x 300 pound (lb.) sockets shall be fitted to the inspection cover to accommodate specified elements and elements fitted as specified.
- g) Note: The designed safe working pressure shall be such that the safety valve shall reset, once operated, at a pressure greater than the required operating pressure, to ensure that the safety valve does not "weep".
- h) On completion of installation, the tank shall be subjected to a hydraulic test, in accordance with the Code of Construction.
- i) Inspection and testing on site, by an approved inspection authority, shall be carried out prior to commissioning and after installation, in accordance with the Vessels under Pressure Regulations, Regulation 13. (1) (a) of the OHS Act, as amended.
- j) A Certificate issued by the inspection authority under whose supervision the pressure vessel is manufactured shall be provided.
- k) NOTE: The installer shall provide a written 1-year guarantee for the work and material and components installed.

1) The contractor must fully familiarise himself with the above documents prior to quoting.

4. TANK DRAIN DISCHARGE

a) Provision of tank drainage via brass ball valve shall be provided and installed to the nearest drain.

5. SAFETY VALVES

- a) The sterilizer shall be fitted with a bronze safety valve of the vertical, direct spring-loaded type, the spring and seat of which shall be stainless steel, with screwed side discharge, directly connected to the steam space at the top of the jacket by a pipe of minimum length.
- b) The safety valve shall be capable of being set and locked by means of a lock and key.
- c) The safety valve shall be set in accordance with Regulation 6 of the OHS Act, as amended.
- d) The safety valve shall be drained by means of a tail pipe, connected to drain at the valve discharge connection point outside the plant.
- e) All safety valves shall be piped separately to a safe, but visible point outside of the plant room building.

 Wherever practicable the safety valve pipeline shall be graded to ensure that condensate flow is away from the safety valve.

6. THERMAL INSULATION AND CLADDING

- a) The hot water storage vessel shall be insulated (top to bottom) externally with rock wool insulation (fiberglass wool type insulation will not be acceptable). Existing insulation cladding sheets to be reinstalled and matched perfectly.
- b) The cladding surface temperature shall not exceed 29°C while in operation.

7. FITTINGS

- a) The following instruments and fittings shall be provided on the tank:
- b) Fit one pressure gauge calibrated 0-1000 kPa (100mm dial) g to register tank pressure and the maximum working pressure marked on the dial in red.
- c) Copper piping used, shall be to SANS 460: 2003- Class 2.
- d) Compression fittings shall only be used for connections to fittings, which require removal for servicing.
- e) Union connection fittings shall be used on all pumps.

8. SERVICES

- a) Where practicable all services i.e., water and electrical supplies, shall be routed overhead and connected to the hot water system.
- b) All services are to be color coded.

Electrical Section

9. CONTROL SYSTEM

- a) Control systems shall be installed in the existing control panel box in such a way as to prevent electromagnetic interference. The control system shall be properly protected against lightning hazards, power surges, mains-borne and other noise interference to prevent malfunctioning of the system. The suppresser shall be as "PONTECH KLEEN-LINE" or other approved.
- b) The wiring function of all components shall be clearly marked. All wiring terminations shall be labeled.(Sample and manner of wire labeling is viewable at A- ward hot water plant.
- c) Control panels shall incorporate a suitably rated lockable electrical isolating switch on the left (outside) the panel.
- d) All components needed for the operation and left in working condition and not reusable form existing control panel, shall be allowed for in the BOQ document

9. HEATING OPERATION MANNER REQUIERED

- a) This unit shall be heated with 3 x 380 volt 12 kw elements and shall protrude 70 % of tanks diameter. Control shall be energized via Rex 100 temperature and pt100 sensor to A1 terminal of the 45 Amp schneider contactor and protected with suitable Schneider suitably rated 3phase contactor. The elements shall be connected in delta configuration.
- b) SANS 60947-1: 2005/IEC 60947-1: 2004 to SANS 60947-8: 2004/IEC 60947-8: 2004: Low voltage switch gear and control gear.
- c) An Electrical Certificate of Compliance, in accordance with the OHS Act as amended will be required for all Electrical Works.
- d) Type AD22-22DSA 0-99 amp LED indicators (RED, WHITE AND BLUE) to be fitted in place of existing blown amp meters and to sense total incoming current of each phase.
