TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION.

Clause T1

The device is designed for use in neonates and children for total body cooling for the purposes of therapeutic hypothermia.

Clause T2

Cooling must occur via a liquid filled cooling mat, and be servo controlled via a rectal temperature probe. Skin temperature monitoring must also be available. At least 10 rectal probes and 10 skin probes must be provided with the apparatus at no extra cost to the final bid price.

Clause T3

Cooling mattresses/pads must be available in different sizes for patients ranging from neonate to large adolescents (up to 50kg). The smaller mattress/pads (suitable for the neonate) must be able to wrap around the baby and be secured.

Clause T4

Cooling mattresses can be either reusable or disposable.

- Reusable mattresses must be water proof and able to withstand cleaning with standard hospital-grade disinfectant. At least 3 reusable mattresses plus 10 disposable liners plus securement devices (in the case of wrap around pads) should be supplied as part of the starter kit, at no extra cost to the final bid price. The size of the mattress is to be determined by the end user.
- Disposable wraps / mattresses should be able to be used on a single patient for at least five (5) days without requiring replacement. At least 10 disposable wraps / mattresses should be supplied in the starter pack at no extra cost to the final bid price. The size of the mattress is to be determined by the end user.

The fluid used to fill the mattress may be water or a specialized liquid with effective heat transfer. The bidder must state what fluid is used in the mattress and what method is used to fill the mattress. All accessories required to fill the mattress must be supplied with the unit at no extra cost.

Clause T5.2

Different sizes of mattress may use different volumes of fluid. The bidder must indicate how much fluid is used to fill each size of mattress that is available. If fluid other than water is used, the bidder must ensure that enough fluid is provided at no extra cost to the final bid price to treat at least 10 patients using the size of mattress that the end-user has chosen.

Clause T6.1

Cooling must be programmable according to either an automated program or manual settings. Where an automated program is available this must include a neonatal mode. This mode must cause rapid cooling to a set temperature of 33-34°C, and rewarm over a period of 6-8 hours. The period of hypothermia (if able to be set) should be approximately 72 hours. Automated settings should be able to be manually overridden by the end user.

Clause T6.2

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Temperature control ranges:

- 6.1 The fluid must be controlled in a range of 13°C to 39°C
- 6.2 The set temperature range should be at least 30°C to 38°C

Clause T7

The hoses connecting the cooling unit to the mattress should be at least 2m in length. Two complete sets of hoses must be supplied with the unit.

Clause T8

The cooling unit dimensions should not exceed H 950mm x W 375mm x D 650 mm. Bidder to state dimensions of the unit on

The cooling unit should be mounted on a trolley which is robust and on castors so that it can be easily maneuvered around the bedside. At least two castors must have brakes.

The cooling unit must have a graphics package which demonstrates the patient temperature, target or set temperature and time elapsed

In the event of a power failure the cooling unit must, on restarting, have the option of resuming the previous settings.

Clause T16

Alarms must be available and must alert the user by audible and / or visual means. At a minimum, the following must be available:

- Deviation from set temperature
- Low fluid level
- Mains power failure

Clause T17

The cooling unit must have capacity to store data to analyze temperature profiles. Data storage should be at least 2 GB and should be able to be downloaded via a USB device.

Clause T18

The unit must operate from a plug inserted into the mains socket which must be off 230V(AC)/50Hz.

All Accessories required for the functioning of the unit must be quoted on the Schedule of Optional accessories, All accessories required for immediate use of the unit, must be supplied with the unit as a starter pack at no extra cost.

1. AMENDMENT OF CONTRACT

1.1. Any amendment to or renunciation of the provisions of the contract shall at all times be done in writing and shall be signed by both parties.

2. CHANGE OF ADDRESS

2.1. Bidders must advise the Department of Health (institution where the offer was submitted) should their address (domicilium citandi et executandi) details change from the time of bidding to the expiry of the contract.

3. GENERAL CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THIS QUOTATION

- 3.1. The institution is under no obligation to accept the lowest or any quote.
- 3.2. The price quoted must include VAT (if VAT vendor). However, it must be noted that the department reserves the right to evaluate all quotations excluding VAT as some bidders may not be VAT vendors.
- 3,3. The bidder must ensure the correctness & validity of quote:
 - (i) that the price(s), rate(s) & preference quoted cover all for the work/item (s) & accept that any mistakes regarding the price (s) & calculations will be at the bidder's risk
- 3.4. The bidder must accept full responsibility for the proper execution & fulfilment of all obligations conditions devolving on under this agreement, as the Principal (s) liable for the due fulfilment of this contract.
- 3.5. This quotation will be evaluated based on the 80/20 points system, specification & correctness of information. All required documentation must be completed in full and submitted.
- 3.6. Offers must comply strictly with the specification.
- 3.7. Only offers that meet or are greater than the specification will be considered.
- 3.8. Late quotes will not be considered.
- 3.9. Expired product/s will not be accepted. All products supplied must be valid for a minimum period of six months.
- 3.10. A bidder not registered on the Central Suppliers Database or verification has failed will not be considered.
- 3.11. All delivery costs must be included in the quote price, for delivery at the prescribed destination.
- 3.12. Only firm prices will be accepted. Such prices must remain firm for the contract period. Non-firm prices (including rates of exchange variations) will not be considered.
- 3.13. In cases where different delivery points influence the pricing, a separate pricing schedule must be submitted for each delivery point.
- 3.14. In the event of a bidder having multiple quotes, only the cheapest according to specification will be considered. Furthermore a verification will be done to identify if bidders have multiple companies and are quoting (cover-quoting) for this bid. 5. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING HAND DELIVERED QUOTATIONS

- 5.1. Quotation shall be lodged at the address indicated not later than the closing time specified for their receipt, and in accordance with the directives in the quotation documents.
- 5.2. Each quotation shall be addressed in accordance with the directives in the quotation documents and shall be lodged in a separate sealed envelope, with the name and address of the bidder, the quotation number and closing date indicated on the envelope. The envelope shall not contain documents relating to any quotation other than that shown on the envelope. If this provision is not complied with, such quotations/bids may be rejected as being invalid.

8. STATEMENT OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

8.1. The contractor shall, when requested to do so, furnish particulars of supplies delivered or services executed. If he/she fails to do so, the Department may, without prejudice to any other rights which it may have, institute inquiries at the expense of the contractor to obtain the required particulars.

9. SUBMISSION AND COMPLETION OF SBD 6.1

9.1. Should a bidder wish to qualify for preference points they must complete a SBD 6.1 document. Failure by a bidder to provide all relevant information required, will result in such a bidder not being considered for preference point's allocation. The preferences applicable on the closing date will be utilized. Any changes after the closing date will not be considered for that particular quote.

10. TAX COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

- 10.1. In the event that the tax compliance status has failed on CSD, it is the suppliers' responsibility to provide a SARS pin in order for the institution to validate the tax compliance status of the supplier.
- 10.2. In the event that the institution cannot validate the suppliers' tax clearance on SARS as well as the Central Suppliers Database, the quote will not be considered and passed over as non-compliant according to National Treasury Instruction Note 4 (a) 2016/17.

11. TAX INVOICE

- 11.1. A tax invoice shall be in the currency of the Republic of South Africa and shall contain the following particulars:

12. PATENT RIGHTS

The supplier shall indemnify the KZN Department of Health (hear after known as the purchaser) against all third-party claims of infringement of patent, trademark, or industrial design rights arising from use of the goods or any part thereof by the purchaser.

13. PENALTIES

- 13.1. If at any time during the contract period, the service provider is unable to perform in a timely manner, the service provider must notify the institution in writing/email of the cause of and the duration of the delay. Upon receipt of the notification, the institution should evaluate the circumstances and, if deemed necessary, the institution may extend the service provider's time for performance.
- 13.2. In the event of delayed performance that extends beyond the delivery period, the institution is entitled to purchase commodities of a similar quantity and quality as a substitution for the outstanding commodities, without terminating the contract, as well as return commodities delivered at a later stage at the service provider's expense.
- 13.3. Alternatively, the institution may elect to terminate the contract and procure the necessary commodities in order to complete the contract. In the event that the contract is terminated the institution may claim damages from the service provider in the form of a penalty. The service provider's performance should be captured on the service provider database in order to determine whether or not the service provider should be awarded any contracts in the future.
- 13.4. If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods or to perform the services within the period(s) specified in the contract, the purchaser shall, without prejudice to its other remedies under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as a penalty, a sum calculated on the delivered price of the delayed goods or unperformed services using the current prime interest rate calculated for each day of the delay until actual delivery or performance.

14. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

- 14.1. The purchaser, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by written notice of default sent to the supplier, may terminate this contract in whole or in part:
- (i) if the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods within the period(s) specified in the contract,
- (ii) if the supplier falls to perform any other obligation(s) under the contract; or
- (iii) if the supplier, in the judgment of the purchaser, has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the contract.
- 14.2.
