1 PURPOSE, SCOPE AND DEFINITIONS OF CONTRACT WORK CATEGORIES

The purpose of this contract specification is to procure the services of a reputable, competent and accredited Contractor to execute the following:

1.1 Autopsy Room 1

a) Installation of high pressure hose pipe and reel for cleaning of autopsy room 1

1.2 Autopsy Room 2

a) Installation of high pressure hose pipe and reel for cleaning of autopsy room 2

1.3 Cold Room

a) Installation of a protective cover for evaporator drain pipes to protect them from being bumped.

1.4 Offices

a) Installation of removed burglar guards on all office doors (4 single doors)

These areas are in the UThukela District Forensic Mortuary – Ladysmith MLM. Details of each of the point items above will be shown to the Contractors during Site briefing.

2 DEFINITIONS OF WORK CATEGORIES

The work categories are as under:

 Maintenance: (including preventive maintenance) defined as work required for the upkeep any existing building works, which is presently functioning, in operational order. Repairs: defined as that work required to be executed on any existing building work, which is at present
not functioning and must be returned to its original state of functioning by replacing it with new equipment
of the same capacity/capability and technological features.

3 CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

3.1 NOTICE TO BIDDERS

- a) The institutions will remain open and operational at all times therefore the Contractor shall make the necessary arrangements with the Institutional Management before commencing works.
- b) The Administration reserves the right to negotiate prices in the Schedule of Prices.
- c) All redundant material and rubble shall be removed from the institution's property immediately.
- d) The Contractor is advised to visit the site prior to tendering to acquaint him/herself with the nature of the work to be done and access to the siting of the existing buildings etc., as no claim will be allowed on the grounds of ignorance of the conditions under which the work will be executed.
- e) All items quantities in the Schedule of equipment are PROVISIONAL and subject to re-measure after Site visit
- f) Any discrepancies or omissions shall be brought to the attention of the Project Leader immediately.
- g) The Contractor must be registered with CIDB and must have minimum grading of 1 SO or 1 ME.
- h) The Contractor must be competent with proven experience in plumbing works with traceable references.

4 EXECUTION PERIOD

Five (5) days is the specified maximum completion period for the repairs of the works from the date of award.

5 TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

5.1 COMPLIANCE WITH REGULATIONS AND STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS

- a) The Contractor shall only use genuine OEM parts to conduct the works.
- b) The Contractor shall observe and abide by all rules and regulations a stipulated in the Occupational Health and Safety Act (Act 85, 1993) while conducting repairs in the facility.
- c) The Contractor shall take cognisance of the standard listed below while conducting the works:
 - SANS 10400: The application of the National Building Regulations

- d) The Contractor shall observe Municipal By-laws and any special requirements of the Supply Authorities of the area or district concerned while conducting the works.
- e) All building works shall be in accordance with the Standard Preambles to All Trades.
- f) The contractor shall fully familiarise himself with these documents prior to quoting.

6 PARTICULAR SPECIFICATION

6.1 TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

6.1.1 GENERAL

This Technical Specification shall be read in conjunction with all other sections of the specification.

6.1.2 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Tenderers are to make special note of the following:

- a) This particular specification must be read with, and shall form part of, Part 5 of this document (Technical Specification).
- b) In so far as the conditions contained herein are at variance with any obtained in the Technical Specifications, the contract shall be interpreted in terms of this Part 6 (Particular Specification).
- c) The whole repairs activity shall be in accordance with the Occupational Health and Safety Act 85/1993 and all regulations framed therein shall be carried out to the satisfaction of the Department of Health.
- d) Competent workmen skilled in their trade shall carry out all work. Quality shall be of the best standard practice and all workmanship will be subject to the approval of the Department of Health.
- e) The work shall at all times, for the duration of the contract, be carried out under the supervision of a skilled and competent representative of the Contractor, who will be able and authorized to receive and carry out instructions on behalf of the Contractor. A sufficient number of workmen shall be employed at all times to ensure satisfactory progress of the work.
- f) All apparatus, component parts, fittings and materials employed in the execution of the Contract shall be new and unused and shall be the latest type or pattern of the particular manufacture employed. S.A.B.S. mark bearing items shall be used wherever possible.
- g) Tenderers are advised to visit the site and acquaint themselves fully with the site conditions and nature and full extent of work involved prior to submitting their tender. Claims on the grounds of insufficient information in such respects or otherwise will not be entertained by the Administration.

7 SCOPE OF CONTRACT

The specification calls for the installation of booster pump, high pressure hose reels in autopsy rooms at Ladysmith Forensic Pathology Services and replacement of removed burglar guards on office doors (4 offices)

7.1 High Pressure Pipe and Retractable Hose Reel Specifications:

Procure, supply, install, commission, and handover of a stainless steel wash down hose reel with a 20 m braiding suitable for water temperature up 90 degrees Celsius and a maximum pressure of 20 bar.



The product shall be complete with all necessary accessories for it to function, i.e. suction pipes, discharge pipes, mounting supports, power cable, etc. The requirements stipulated above are not cast in concrete, however indicative of the requirement product. Alternative products will be acceptable subject to detail product specification provided.

- The pump shall be installed only to boost the pressure going to the high pressure hose reels to each autopsy room. At suitable buffer take of 100 litres shall be procure and installed on the suction side of the booster pump to ensure the pump never run dry. The buffer tank shall be complete with inlet pipe (high level), float valve to stop inflow of water once the tank reach high level and outlet pipe (low level) which shall be connected to the suction side of the pump.
- The discharge pipe of the pump shall be connected to the piping feeding both high pressure hose reels.
- Isolation valves shall be installed on the suction and discharge side of the pump.
- The pump shall come complete which a pressure regulation system which shall allow it to start and start as required or demanded by the use of the hose reels. See typical details below.



7.3 Installation of Burglar Guards on Office Doors (4 Offices)

Details of this will be confirmed during Site briefing with the Contractors.

The Contractor shall inform the Chief Artisan/Engineer of all defects found, especially those that need urgent attention. Submit the after service report no later than 3 days after service and inspection. No invoice will be paid without a comprehensive report.

The Department shall have the right to instruct the Service Provider to remove from site any of the Service Provider's employees who at the sole and absolute discretion of the Department is found to be:

- a) Incompetent.
- b) Not properly qualified and/or not suitably skilled to perform his/her respective tasks.
- c) Is found to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs, or disorderly on Site.
- d) Is unwilling to perform his respective tasks.

8 THE SITE

The site is at the Ladysmith Medico Legal Mortuary KwaZulu-Natal.

Tenderers are encouraged to visit the site to ensure successful installation of the work required. Arrangements in this regard can be made with the representative from the department of health.

8.1 PROGRAM OF WORKS

It is imperative that the repairs be executed with minimum interruption to the facility.

The contractor shall notify the facility seven (7) days prior to carrying out the repair works. As the facility is to remain in full operation for the duration of the works, the works are to be planned and executed so as to cause minimum disturbance.

A program shall be submitted prior to the commencement of any work for the approval by the Project Leader. No work will commence without the program of works having been approved by the Project Leader.
