- In the event of delayed performance that extends beyond the delivery period, the institution is entitled to purchase commodities of a similar 13,2. quantity and quality as a substitution for the outstanding commodities, without terminating the contract, as well as return commodities delivered at a later stage at the service provider's expense.
- Alternatively, the institution may elect to terminate the contract and procure the necessary commodities in order to complete the contract.
