The black people who are LOCAL must submit proof of address from Ward Counsellor or Utility Bill as a proof that they reside within catchment area. Tenderer (Bidder) failing to comply with the above will be regarded as non-responsive and immediately be disqualified		
5. The main contractor and subcontracted company must submit valid proof of joint venture agreement signed as an affidavit in front of Commissioner of Oaths. Note. We reserve the right to check for validity of the joint venture agreement. Tenderer (Bidder) subcontracting but failing this criteria will be regarded as non-responsive and will immediately be disqualified
