This specification calls for the ONCE OFF servicing and cleaning of TEN (10) Water Tanks at R.K. Khan Hospital

- 2. SCOPE OF WORK
- 2.1. To drain water tank.
- 2.2. To clean walls and floor with high pressure cleaner with an appropriate with an ammonia/ chlorine based detergent.
- 2.3. MSDS (Material safety data sheets of the cleaner/ chemical used must be submitted with the quotation)
- **2.4.** The detergents must be thoroughly rinsed and drained prior to refilling the tanks.
- **2.5.** Contractors are required to report all defects to the maintenance department.
- 2.6. All air-vents and surrounding walls in the enclosed room are to be cleaned.
- 2.7. To refill the tank after completion of cleaning.

11. TAX INVOICE

- 13.1. If at any time during the contract period, the service provider is unable to perform in a timely manner, the service provider must notify the institution in writing/email of the cause of and the duration of the delay. Upon receipt of the notification, the institution should evaluate the circumstances and, if deemed necessary, the institution may extend the service provider's time for performance.
- 13.2. In the event of delayed performance that extends beyond the delivery period, the institution is entitled to purchase commodities of a similar quantity and quality as a substitution for the outstanding commodities, without terminating the contract, as well as return commodities delivered at a later stage at the service provider's expense.
- 13.3. Alternatively, the institution may elect to terminate the contract and procure the necessary commodities in order to complete the contract. In the event that the contract is terminated the institution may claim damages from the service provider in the form of a penalty. The service provider's performance should be captured on the service provider database in order to determine whether or not the service provider should be awarded any contracts in the future.
- 13.4.
