SCOPE OF WORK: 12 MONTHS CONTRACT FOR PEST CONTROL SERVICE IN
OTHOBOTHINI CHC AND FIVE CLINICS

Requirements

- The contractor is requested to provide a monthly service of pest control dealing with / eliminating :
 1. All types of insects including cockroaches
 2. Mice and rats
 3. Bees
 4. Drains & Pavements
- Service provider shall use professional proper chemical and standard industry procedures to determine the means necessary to correct the pest problem.
- Selecting and implementing the appropriate treatment procedures.
- Inspect and monitoring to evaluate results and to detect new pest invasion
- Determine areas requiring treatment both with non – chemical methods and pesticides.
- The service provider shall be fully responsible for arranging adequate insurance cover for all risks arising out of performance of its service under this contract e.g COIDA
- Service provider to provide the institution with " Material Data Sheets " in respect of all pesticides which will be used , and material must be acceptable to the institution
- Mixing of the chemicals must be done on site.
- The service is requested once monthly
- Professional trained personnel to do the job must be appointed in writing
- Service provider must ensure that the correct protective clothing be worn at all times, for a personnel conducting this job to prevent infection
- Schedule of visits must be provided prior to commencement of the service

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- Service provider must inform the responsible personnel on arrivals and each section must sign as a proof of service
- Provision of service certificate must be done for each service provided
- Required to comply with the requirement of occupational health and Safety Act 85 of 1993
- Must be available within 24 hours to address unexpected emergencies related to pest infections in the CHC, five clinics and staff residents at no additional costs
- All calls be treated as serious, inspections shall begin within 24 hours of the initial call.
