There are 120 patients who were seen the first day. The first patient came in at 07:45 who is Celimpilo Magagula from eNdabeni area who was very much excited to see this facility functioning and she said that she couldn't wait to access health services.

Moreover, the facility was blessed with the newborn on 17th April 2018 at 4:55. Sindisiwe Mkhumbuzi from oThobothini area in Ward 8 which is a walking distance from the CHC delivered CHC's first baby. She came at 08:00pm on 16th and gave birth at 4:55 in the morning following day. The baby's name is Bongeka Alonde Gumede (Female) weighing 2.9kg.

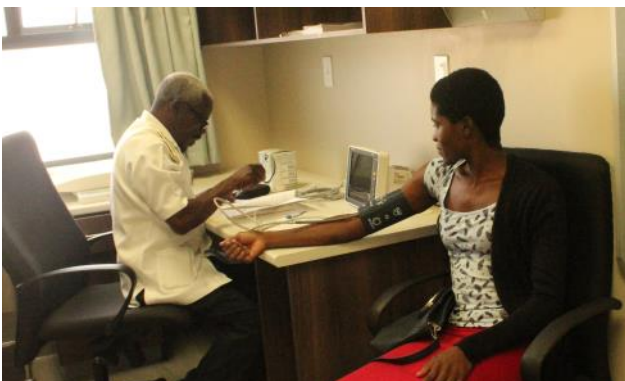
