## STAY INFORMED April 2016 MEC MARCH AGAINST ILLEGAL ABORTIONS

KwaZulu-Natal Health MEC, Dr Sibongiseni Dhlomo and the district manager for Zululand health district, Mr Vusi Vilakazi have taken the fight against illegal abortions to Ulundi and Nongoma (Zululand District). This was during the MEC visit to Ulundi on the 17<sup>th</sup> March 2016. Dr. Sibongiseni Dhlomo speaking in the Municipality Offices handed over a memorandum to the South African Police Services (SAPS). He also called on for support and action against the scourge of illegal abortions. The event was well attended by the community, government departments, Nongoma Christian fraternal and traditional healers.

According to a press statement the MEC spoke outside the Ulundi Municipality Offices after leading a march through the central business district from the taxi Rank, Dr Dhlomo implored SAPS to ensure that they investigate, arrest and prosecute perpetrators to the full might of

the law.

He said the so called "abortion clinics" must be identified, and that their owners are prosecuted and the buildings shut down.

Posters, pamphlets and materials advertising illegal termination of pregnancies should be removed by their placers as they murky municipal spaces said the MEC for health.

The MEC also said all women presenting to health institutions (hospitals and clinics) with complications following illegal termination of pregnancy, should be assisted to open cases against the perpetrator; and the SAPS and Department of Health commit to working together in removing these rogue elements from unsuspecting citizens so as to eradicate the scourge of illegal termination of pregnancies.

Dr Dhlomo also said that it had been brought to his attention that some health care professionals passed moral judgment on young people when they sought reproductive health services. This, he said, was a contributing factor to the rate of illegal abortions.

However, to mitigate this, the Department would be promoting a Youth User-Friendly approach to health care provision, he said.
