On the 24th of March 2022, we had a TB awareness event, with the aim of reducing the spread of TB. East Boom CHC manages many cases of Pulmonary and Extra-Pulmonary TB.

Pulmonary T.B is when the infection affects the lungs and Extra-pulmonary T.B is when the infection affects other organs and not the lungs

Medication need to be taken 6-9 months, the term will depend on which drug works to eradicate T.B. Signs and symptoms usually include coughing blood, pains on the chest whilst breathing, shortness of breath, chills, fatique, fever, loss of appetite resulting weight loss, malaise, night sweats or sweating and swollen lymph nodes.

T. B can be tested by blood test, sputum and a chest X-Ray and urine.

Its important to screen for TB regularly in order to treat it as soon as possible and prevent the spread as it is highly contagious.
