Dietetics Department information regards Nutritional Packs

Nutrition Care Packs

Are Now available from Home Based Care

Aims:

- Improve treatment outcome for children with malnutrition
- Improve treatment outcome for people with TB and HIV
- Improve adherence and reduce side effects
- Improve nutritional status

Each pack contains:

- Maize meal (5kg)
- Rice (2kg)
- Sugar (2.5kg)
- Sugar beans (2.5kg)
- Soya Mince (1kg)
- Iodated salt (500g)
- Tinned fish
- Full cream milk powder (500g)
- Nutritional paste/butter (500g)
- Enriched porridge (1kg)

Who qualifies?

- Malnourished children 1-14 years
- Children on TB treatment
- Children on ARV
- Pregnant women on TB or ARV
- Breastfeeding women on the PMTCT programme
- TB patients on treatment
- HIV/AIDS patients on treatment

Important notes

- The patient can only receive the packs for 6 months
- A relative can come on behalf of the patient to collect the pack, but must bring the patients file with them

This programme can run concurrently with the PEM scheme
