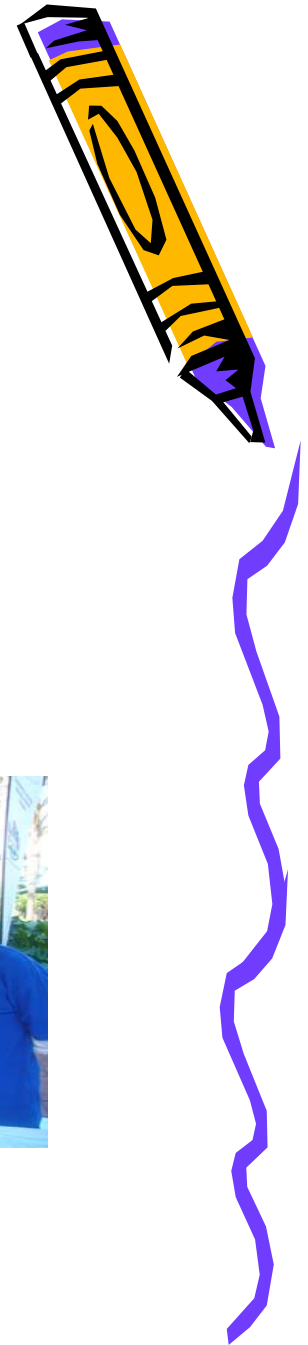
- Health Promotion and Mental Health Awareness is an ongoing project at Fort Napier Hospital. Part of this project is a community outreach programme.

There was a very festive atmosphere among all who joined in to set up the information stand.

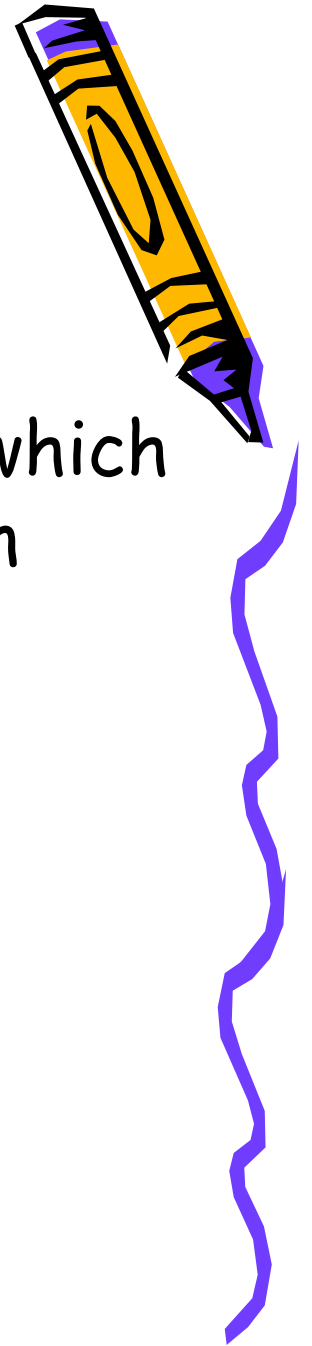


Many information pamphlets on various topics were handed out to the visitors to our stand

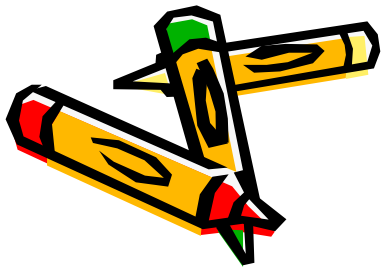


• Among the more frequent requests were:
