



To significantly reduce your risk, take precautionary measures against mosquito bites throughout the year in ALL RISK areas

**Malaria Risk Area**

Antimalarial drugs\* are recommended from October to May for all travellers. Particularly high risk areas include Ndumu & Tembe game reserves

**Intermediate Risk Areas**

High risk persons\*\* are advised to take antimalarial drugs from October through May

**Low Risk Areas**

Antimalarial drugs are not recommended

**Mozambique**

Malaria all year round: antimalarial drugs\* are recommended

**Swaziland**

Travellers are advised to take antimalarial drugs from October through May, particularly high risk people\*\*

\* Mefloquine OR Doxycycline (OR Chloroquine PLUS Proguanil)

\*\* High risk persons are children < 5 years, pregnant women & immunocompromised people (e.g. HIV, a person who has had a splenectomy, or who is on immunosuppressant medication)
