In April this year the Provincial Department of Health embarked on a programme of training emergency care-practitioners in basic life support. This initiative was started as a pilot programme driven by Emergency Medical Rescue Services (EMRS), which falls within the Provincial Department of Health.

Since it is a pilot programme only 50 candidates were going to the taken into the programme. The 50 candidates were selected throughout the province and as part of the selection criteria they had to be unemployed, be in possession of a Grade 12 certificate and they had to be individuals who have not been presented with an opportunity to further their studies at tertiary level.

The Department is glad to announce that this group of enthusiastic youth has been selected and will beginning their three-months training programme on Monday, 8 August 2005.
