ANOTHER HELICOPTER FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL RESCUE SERVICES

The KZN Department of Health is beefing up its emergency services in the province as a second rotor helicopter will be delivered tomorrow. Apart from having emergency care vehicles, highly trained paramedics, ERMS has a fixed wing aeroplane and 1 rotor helicopter, which are both based in Durban. But to ensure that aero medical care reaches all areas of KwaZulu-Natal, EMRS will take delivery of the second rotor helicopter in Richards Bay. The helicopter will respond to critical medical emergencies in areas in northern KwaZulu-Natal, which include, uThungulu, Mkhanyakude and Zululand Districts.

The delivery and handover of the helicopter will take place as follows:
