Today, the MEC for Health, Dr Sibongiseni Dhlomo, paid a surprise visit to two midlands hospitals (Emmaus and Escourt) as part of his stated commitment to go around the province to see to the delivery of quality health care.

"In the spirit of improving quality of care in the province, we want to inculcate the practice where managers are visible in their hospitals so that the public can access them and engage them on the delivery of responsive health care. It was for that reason that today I paid a surprise visit to Emmaus and Escourt Hospitals in the midlands" the MEC said.
