7.	How often should you feed your baby? (Describes feeding on demand)					
8.	What have you been taught about breast feeding? (Mother can explain benefits of breast feeding, how long to breast feed at home & how to seek help.)					
9.	If you have chosen not to breast feed have you been told again the benefits of breastfeeding and taught how to prepare formula?					
10.	What have you been taught about caring for baby's cord? (Mother can explain-Keep dry, clean with spirits, keep out of nappy, don't put anything on the cord)					
11.	If teenager <18 years: Have you been seen by a social worker?					
12.	Do you know your HIV status?					
13.	If yes & positive-Do you know when to get the results for your baby, what treatment to give (Within 1 week, Nevirapine for 6 wks) & how to feed baby? (exclusive for 6mths-continue for 12 mths)					
14.	If yes and negative- When should you be retested? (Every 3mths)					
15.	Have you received a contraceptive method in addition to condoms?					
16.	Have the nurses taught you about signs that tell you that your baby might be sick and what to do? (Yellow colour/ vomiting/ noisy/fast breathing/ poor feeding/ excessive sleeping- return urgently to clinic/hospital)					
17.	Have you been given a Road to Health Book and explained about its use and importance and when to immunise your baby?					
18.	Were you told when to bring your baby back to this facility or another for review? (Within 1 week)					
19.	Have you been told about CCG visits (in the 1 st 3-6 days) and how to contact one?
