

# ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION REGULATIONS, 1992

### Responsibility for electrical installations


2 (1) User or lessor of electrical installation responsible for the safety, use and maintenance of installations

2(2) User or lessor of electrical installation responsible for the safety of conductors connecting installation to the point of supply where point of supply is not point of control



#### Certificate of compliance

- 3 (1) User or lessor to have a valid certificate after 1992 unless maintenance or repairs of compliance as well as for additions or alterations
- 3 (2) Certificate to be available for inspector if requested
- 3 (4) Supplier may at any reasonable time inspect or test any installation and shall not charge any fee unless inspection was requested by user or lessor
- 3 (5) New certificate may be required if fault has been found by inspector or a supplier unless immediately dangerous to lift whereby the supply may be discontinued



#### Construction

4 (1) All installations to be in accordance with a safety standard or where provision is not made, in accordance with bylaws or supplier regulations



## Commencement of and permission to connect installation work

- 6 (1) No person shall commence with installation work unless supplier has been notified
- 6 (2) No supplier shall connect the electricity supply unless certificate of compliance has been issued (does not apply to non-payment or change of tenant not of ownership
- 6 (3) No person to connect supply unless it has been inspected and tested by an accredited person and certificate issued

## Issuing of a certificate of compliance

7 (1) Only an accredited person may issue a certificate of compliance

7 (2) If any fault is found, accredited person shall refuse such certificate and take steps to disconnect supply if

immediate danger is posed





- 9 (1)(a) Applications for registration are to be made through CI
- 9 (1) (b) Fees are payable for application
- 9 (2) Applicant to satisfy CI of experience, knowledge and possesses the necessary qualifications afterwhich certificate will be issued
- 9 (3) Accredited person to produce certificate when requested
- 9 (4) CI can cancel certificate if certificate is tampered with
- 9 (5) CI may cancel, suspend or endorse certificate if holder has been guilty of gross negligence
