Reporting of Incidents: Section 24

- 24.(1) (a) Report to inspector regarding certain incidents <u>occurring at work</u> or use of plant or machinery in which -
 - any person <u>dies</u>,
 - becomes <u>unconscious</u>,
 - suffers the <u>loss of a limb</u> or part of a limb or
 - injured or becomes ill to such a degree to be <u>unable to work for at</u> <u>least 14 days;</u>

ACCIDENT VESTIGATION

Incident Reporting

- (b) a major incident occurred; or
- (c) the health or safety of any person was endangered and where
 - (i) a dangerous <u>substance was</u> <u>spilled;</u>
 - (ii) the <u>uncontrolled release</u> of any substance;
 - (iii) <u>machinery failed</u> resulting in uncontrolled moving objects; or
 - (iv) machinery ran out of control.

ACCIDEN

INCIDENT REPORTING excluding


Excludes

- > a traffic accident on a public road
- private household (but must be reported to Police)
- > any accident investigated under Aviation Act
- any shipping incident occurring Merchant Shipping Act (Captain Control)

INCIDENT REPORTING by Doctors

OCCUPATIONAL DISEASES

Any medical practitioner shall report to the chief inspector any diagnosed disease as per COIDA or any other disease that is related to employment {WCL 1}

INCIDENT DESCRIPTION	REPORTABLE	NOT REPORTABLE
A domestic servant falls off a ladder and fractures a leg.		
A lift falls uncontrolled down a lift shaft, nobody is injured		
An employee cuts his hand at work, the nurse treats the wound in the factory clinic, and he returns to work.		
An employee cuts his/her hand at work and is booked off work for 15 days by the Doctor.		
Two employees moving a 210 litre container of Trichloroethylene accidentally drop the container spilling the contents.		
An employee cuts off a finger whilst operating a wood band saw.		
Two trains collide at a railway station causing an explosion and major fire.

INCIDENT DESCRIPTION	REPORTABLE	NOT REPORTABLE
A taxi has an accident on a national freeway killing 10 persons		
A crane hoist rope on a building site for a new shopping centre breaks cause the bucket load of cement to fall – no persons injured		
A seaman breaks his leg on a South African owned ship whilst in international waters.		
After working for 10 yrs in a noise zone above 85 db, the audiometric report indicates a noise induced hearing loss has occurred.		
A South African rifleman breaks a leg falling from a lookout tower in a declared war zone.		
A trench collapses killing two employees, whilst they were laying pipes
