Certified copies of highest educational qualifications – not copies of certified copies. Certified Copy of a driver's license
- 2. The reference number must be indicated in the column provided on the form Z.83 e.g. reference number UMKH 7/2023. **NB:** Failure to comply with above instructions will disqualify applicants.
