REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBSPECIALTY TRAINING

- MBCHB or equivalent and FCPaed or MMED
- Current registration with HPCSA as a paediatrician.
- Basic knowledge of relevant subspecialty
- Knowledge of Medical Practice Ethics, research and academic ethics, and an interest in conducting research.
- Knowledge of Patient's Rights Charter and Batho Pele Principle
- Persons living with disabilities are encouraged to apply
- Preference: 2 years' experience as a paediatrician
- Valid driver's license

KEY PERFORMANCE AREAS

- Participation in academic and teaching programmes and meetings in the respective departments.
- Responsibility for care of patients at designated hospital and units.
- Management of patients under supervision.
- Attendance at ward rounds and/or tutorials.
- Supervision and teaching of undergraduates, registrars, medical officers, nursing and ancillary staff.
- Provision of after-hours care for emergency services.
- Clerking and keeping of comprehensive records of patients in the hospital file.
- Outreach activities as planned by the Clinical Supervisor.
- All administration related to training as per CMSA and UKZN requirements.

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ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

The APFP builds capacity on the African continent by providing in depth paediatric specialisation and subspecialisation training. Training takes place at the UKZN Department of Paediatrics and Child Health, Inkosi Albert Luthuli Central Hospital and affiliated teaching hospitals in Durban in approved DOH posts. Upon completion, graduates will be expected to sit for the Cert Paed Neonatology (SA) and work towards a MMed Sci degree. The candidate will be part of a rich and diverse African paediatric network.

NEONATOLOGY SUBSPECIALTY TRAINING

The Department of Paediatrics and Child Health has two training opportunities for candidates who are already in DOH posts to be appointed for in-service training with line manager approval.

The trainee will be expected to register with UKZN at own expense and sign a contract which includes training and service responsibilities. In addition, the trainee will be required to complete a performance agreement and assessments as stipulated by UKZN and KZN DOH.
